Syngenta expects underlying sales growth to pick up pace in the second half of the year, after a cold, wet spring hit earnings in the first six months. Syngenta said it was confident that high commodity prices will encourage farmers to invest in crops in the second half of the year, when demand is driven by South American farmers, and help its 2013 sales surpass last year's record of \$14.2 billion. Sales at Syngenta rose 2% in the first half to \$8.39 billion, falling short of the Reuters analyst consensus of \$8.64 billion.

Swiss drugmaker *Roche* faces the need to hire an outsider to replace its chairman of 16 years after its most suitable board members turned down the job. The world's largest manufacturer of cancer drugs set itself an autumn deadline to find a successor to Franz Humer, an influential, hands-on former Roche chief executive who says he will not stand for re-election next year. Roche has struggled to diversify beyond its cancer expertise and recently halted development of a diabetes drug. It has been seeking financing for a potential bid for Alexion Pharmaceuticals Inc, which would mark a shift into treatments for rare diseases. A challenge for the new chairman will be bridging differences in culture between Roche's home town of Basel and San Francisco, the base for its employees at Genentech, whose revolutionary cancer drugs have dominated Roche's pipeline since the Swiss firm took it over in 2009.

Novartis recently raised its full-year outlook after generic competition to its best-selling blood pressure pill was delayed, granting the Swiss drugmaker a temporary reprieve from patent losses. The firm lost its patent rights on Diovan in the United States last year and faced competition from a copycat version of its monotherapy from Ranbaxy Laboratories. But the lab has so far failed to get a green light for production from U.S. regulators. Second-quarter core earnings per share fell 4% to \$1.30, undershooting the Reuters analyst consensus of \$1.34. Net sales inched up 1% to \$14.488 billion, compared to the average poll forecast of \$14.314 billion. Helping to compensate for patent losses was the strong performance of new drugs, which contributed to one third of group net sales. Despite competition from rival products, sales of multiple sclerosis pill Gilenya shot up 65%, while revenues from cancer drug Afinitor jumped 76%. The group was also pinning its hopes for growth in emerging markets, where sales in China rose 25% in constant currencies in the quarter. The arrival of Novartis' new chairman Jörg Reinhardt on Aug. 1st has prompted some analysts and investors to wonder whether the company may spin off some of its smaller units or sell its stake in Roche.
