Swiss contract manufacturer *Siegfried* has acquired *Alliance Medical Products* (AMP), based in Irvine, CA, USA for \$58 million. This acquisition gives Siegfried an entry into the custom market for sterile filling services. Founded in 2001, AMP achieved revenues of \$20 million in 2011 with approximately 100 employees. In order to ensure a seamless integration the management of AMP will remain in place.

France plans to ban a pesticide made by Swiss agro-chemical group *Syngenta* that is widely used to treat rapeseed crops after scientists suggested it could pose danger to bees. A sharp decline in bee populations across the world in recent years, partly due to a phenomenon known as Colony Collapse Disorder, has prompted criticism of pesticide use, although research has yet to show clearly the causes of falling bee numbers. France intends to withdraw the permit of the Cruiser OSR pesticide used for coating rape seeds, pending a two-week period during which Syngenta can submit its own evidence, Agriculture Minister Le Foll said on Friday. The decision was based on a report from French health and safety agency ANSES, which went along with recent scientific findings suggesting that a sub-lethal dose of thiamethoxam, a molecule contained in Cruiser, made bees more likely to lose their way and die.

The ETH Board appointed *Jennifer Rupp*, Head of a research group at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Boston, USA, as Assistant Professor (SNF) of Electrochemical Materials. Jennifer Rupp obtained her doctorate from ETH Zurich. She researches electric and dielectric properties of complex metal oxides in the form of thin films with potential application for data storage in fuel cells or in miniaturised switching elements.

Professor *Ryan Gilmour* (*1980), Assistant Professor of Synthetic Organic Chemistry, will leave ETH Zurich as of 30 September 2012 to accept a professorship at the Westphalian-Wilhelms University of Münster, Germany.

Honors

Frédéric Merkt, Professor for Physical Chemistry at ETH Zurich and Member of CHIMIA's advisory board, received the 2012 van't Hoff Prize at the 111th Annual General Meeting of the German Bunsen-Society from 17-19 May 2012 in Leipzig. The van't Hoff Prize was established in 2008 by Gerhard Ertl in remembrance of the first Nobel Prize winner in chemistry, Jacobus Henricus van't Hoff. The award consists of a Silver Medal, a Certificate and €20.000. The prize is awarded for outstanding and sustained contributions to the field of Physical Chemistry to an active scientist. Merkt shares the prize with Geradus Meijer, director at the Fritz-Haber-Institute of the Max-Planck-Society, Berlin.
